


We want to highlight that the bulls are cataloged by sire group first, then by birth-date, so be sure to check out all the bulls from front to back!

Bulls are kept till May 1st free of charge. After that there will be a \$4/day charge. Free delivery in MN and surrounding states for accumulated purchases of \$4,500 or more (bulls & heifers). Take your bull home sale day and receive \$100 off per bull.

All animals are guaranteed healthy on sale day and on delivery day.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Terms of sale are cash or check. No animals will be released from the farm until full payment is made. Cattle will sell according to the terms and conditions suggested by the Red Angus Association of America.

GUARANTEE

All animals are sold to be guaranteed breeders. Bulls will pass a breeding soundness exam before delivery. Open heifers will be confirmed open and breedable before the sale. Bred heifers will be confirmed bred before the sale. In the events of unsatisfactory breeding performance, either a replacement bull or sale credit will be provided, when the defective animal is returned to us in a good state of health.

SEMEN INTEREST

A&R Red Angus is retaining 1/3 semen interest and selling 100% possession in all the bulls unless other terms are state. If semen is collected it will be done at sellers' expense and buyers' convenience.

PICTURES & VIDEOS

100% honest pictures and videos taken by us! If you like them in the picture or video, you will like them on sale day.

SUPPLEMENT SHEET

A supplement sheet will be available prior to sale day. Supplement sheet will include carcass ultrasound data, scrotal circumference, current weights and average daily gain.

INSURANCE

Animals become the property of the buyer when the sale is over. We recommend getting insurance on the animals.

LIABILITY

Any person attending the sale does so at their own risk. Neither the owners, or any person connected with this sale assumes any liability, legal or otherwise for any accidents or injuries that happen on the farm.

CATTLE VIEWING

You are welcome to view the bulls and heifers prior to the sale, and we encourage you to do so. All the sale animals will be available for viewing on the farm and sorted into pens for viewing on sale day. Dams are also at the farm and available to be viewed.

VOLUME DISCOUNTS

- Volume discounts apply to bulls only.
- We will give an 8% discount on the third bull purchased from A&R Red Angus over any period. This allows even the small buyers to receive a discount.
- Purchase three bulls from A&R Red Angus and receive 8% off on your third bull.
- When three bulls are purchased at the same sale, the discount will be applied to the lowest-priced bull.
- For bulls purchased over multiple years, the discount will be applied at the time the third bull is purchased.
- Discounts are non-transferable and apply only to bulls purchased directly from A&R Red Angus.
- Program applies to the current year's sale and going forward: past purchases do not apply.
- We will keep track of the bulls you buy for your convenience.

SALE FORMAT & BIDDING

Our sale will be conducted online through DVAuction. Bulls may be viewed at our farm during our open house or anytime prior to the sale by appointment. Complete catalog information, pictures, and videos will be available on our website and on DVAuction, and hard copies of the catalog are available upon request.

To bid, buyers must create a DVAuction account and apply for bidding in advance. The quickest way to be approved is by entering a credit card number. Your credit card will not be charged; all payments are made directly to A&R Red Angus.

Bidding will open Friday, March 20th at 7:00 AM and will begin closing Saturday, March 21st at 4:00 PM. During the sale, bidders may place incremental bids as the auction advances or enter a confidential maximum bid, which the system will represent on your behalf.

All bids are confidential, and we cannot see who is bidding, ensuring an honest and fair auction. All lots are scheduled to close at 4:00 PM on March 21st. If a bid is placed within the final 5 minutes, the auction will extend 5 minutes on all lots until no bids have been placed for 5 consecutive minutes.

We like this format because it allows you time to study the bulls and bid from the comfort of your home. If you are outbid on your first choice, you have time to evaluate and bid on another lot without pressure.

FOOT & LEG SCORING REFERENCE

Sound feet and legs are something we never take lightly in our program. We are constantly evaluating how our cattle stand, how they travel, and how their feet hold up over time, because good foot structure directly impacts longevity and profitability.

We pay close attention to claw shape, heel depth, foot angle, and overall leg set. We do not trim feet— bulls need to work for a living, and should be sound structured and hold up without added labor or expense. Bulls with good feet are better equipped to cover pasture and breed cows year after year, and just as importantly, they pass those traits on.

Replacement daughters must be able to graze, stay sound, and raise calves without lameness or foot issues. Cows with poor feet often struggle to breed back, raise a quality calf, and ultimately leave the herd sooner than they should.

This foot structure reference chart is a tool we use to help evaluate structure. While perfect feet are always the goal, our focus is on cattle that are problem-free, functional, and built to last— because longevity and profitability go hand in hand.

Foot and Leg Scoring Reference


CLAW SHAPE Reference: Shape (primarily curl) and unevenness of the claw set.



FOOT ANGLE Reference: Strength of pastern, depth of heel and length of foot.



REAR LEG SIDE VIEW Reference: Angle measured at the front of the hock.



UDDER QUALITY

A sound udder is a must in the cow-calf business, and it is something we place a high priority on in our program. Poor udders create extra work and often require helping calves get started nursing – something we simply don't have time for. It is critical for a newborn calf to get up and nurse as soon as possible, and that cannot happen if a cow has an unsound udder or poorly sized teats. While udders cannot be seen in the bull pen, we strongly encourage you to tour our cow herd to see firsthand the udders behind these bulls. Bulls out of sound-uddered dams are far more likely to pass those traits on to their daughters, which is essential for long-term herd success. This udder suspension and teat size guideline is a handy reference we use at calving time to help evaluate udders in a consistent, practical way. While a perfect udder is always the goal, our focus is on cattle that are problem-free, functional, and built to last – because longevity and profitability go hand in hand. A bad udder will put a cow on the cull list in a hurry.

Red Angus Guide to EPDS and Indexes

ProS – Profitability and Sustainability is an all-purpose index that predicts average economic differences in all segments in the beef supply chain. This index is a combination of the breeding objectives modeled in the HerdBuilder and GridMaster selection indexes. In this index, replacement heifers are retained from within the herd and all remaining progeny are fed out to slaughter and sold on a quality-based grid. Traits included in this index include CED, ADG, HPG, STAY, MW, DMI, CW, MARB, REA and Fat.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

HB – HerdBuilder is a maternal selection index that predicts the economic differences of animals for traits that are important from conception through weaning.

HB is calculated based on the scenario that bulls are mated to heifers and cows, replacement heifers are retained and all remaining progeny are marketed at weaning.

This index is a combination of CED, CEM, WW, Milk, MW, HPG and STAY.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

GM – GridMaster is a selection index that predicts the average economic difference of non-replacement calves through the post-weaning phase of production. GM places selection pressure on growth, feed yard performance and carcass traits.

GM is calculated based on the scenario that progeny are fed out to slaughter and marketed on a quality-based carcass grid. This index is a combination of ADG, CW, DMI, MARB, Fat and REA.

Index | Dollars per Head | Higher Value

CED – Calving Ease Direct predicts differences in the percent of calves born unassisted out of 2-year-old dams.

Percent | Higher Value

BW – Birth Weight predicts differences in actual birth weight of progeny. **Pounds | Lower Value**

WW – Weaning Weight predicts differences in 205-day weaning weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

YW – Yearling Weight predicts differences in 365-day yearling weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

ADG – Average Daily Gain predicts differences in weight gain between 205 and 365 days of age. **Pounds | Higher Value**

DMI – Dry Matter Intake predicts differences in daily feed intake as measured in a feedlot during the post-weaning period.

Pounds | Lower Value

MILK – Milk predicts differences in weaning weight attributed to the milking ability of the animal's daughters. **Pounds | Higher Value**

ME – Maintenance Energy predicts the difference in maintenance energy requirements. **Mcals per Month | Lower Value**

HPG – Heifer Pregnancy predicts differences in the percent of daughters who are able to conceive and calve at 2 years of age following exposure to breeding. **Percent | Higher Value**

CEM – Calving Ease Maternal predicts differences in the percent of daughters who are able to calve unassisted as 2-year-old heifers.

Percent | Higher Value

STAY – Stayability predicts differences in the ability of an animals' retained daughters to remain productive in the herd – calve every year – through 6 years of age. **Percent | Higher Value**

MARB – Marbling predicts differences in marbling score – amount of intramuscular fat measured at the 13th rib.

Marbling Score Units | Higher Value

YG – Yield Grade predicts differences in USDA Yield Grade, which is calculated using CW, REA and Fat. **Yield Grade Units | Lower Value**

CW – Carcass Weight predicts differences in actual hot carcass weight. **Pounds | Higher Value**

REA – Ribeye Area predicts differences in square inches of ribeye area measured at the 13th rib. **Square Inches | Higher Value**

FAT – Fat predicts differences in the depth of backfat measured between the 12th and 13th ribs. **Inches | Lower Value**

About the Bulls

DEVELOPMENT PHILOSOPHY

These yearling bulls are developed with durability, longevity, and athleticism in mind – built to cover more cows and hold up year after year, no matter the conditions. Rather than chasing extreme weights, we grow our bulls at a sensible rate to allow them to mature naturally and stay sound for the long haul.

FEED TEST & PERFORMANCE

The bulls were weighed on October 31st and again on February 5th to complete a 97-day feed test, during which the group averaged an impressive 3.3 lbs per day gain. Following the test, they were transitioned to a balanced ration to get them hardened up and ready to go to work for you.

SELECTION & DISPOSITION

From birth to sale day, every bull is evaluated for disposition, structural and breeding soundness, performance, and overall health. Any bull that does not meet our standards is culled. This year, nearly 50% of our bull calf crop was cut to ensure we offer only the most uniform and highest-quality set of bulls we've ever assembled. Great disposition is a must, especially with our kids involved in many day-to-day chores.

BUILT FOR REAL-WORLD PERFORMANCE

These bulls are not pushed; they are developed to work. While cattle can perform on many types of feed, what matters most is having bulls that stay sound, hold condition, and last. That's where we take pride – raising bulls that get the job done year after year.

FOOT STRUCTURE & LONGEVITY

Foot quality is a major focus in our program. The depth of quality in this offering runs deep, with dark-colored feet and adequate heel depth designed to stand the test of time.

HEALTH PROGRAM

All yearling bulls are on a complete vaccination and health program. Bulls received Bovi-Shield Gold FP5 L5, Covexin 8, and were poured with ivermectin at branding on May 18th, preconditioning on August 15th, and at weaning on September 5th. A wart vaccine was administered on December 25th with a booster on January 11th.

NUTRITION & MANAGEMENT

Bulls are developed on a high-forage diet consisting of corn silage, earlage, dry corn, and the Hubbard Express Grower 40:22 MON 400 protein pellet, with free-choice dry hay. Ample space is provided to allow for exercise and maintain athleticism.

THE OFFERING

This offering is exceptionally consistent from top to bottom and represents the best group of bulls we have raised to date. These bulls reflect the kind of cattle we believe in – sound, functional, consistent, and built to work for the long haul. We encourage you to come view them in person anytime!

His granddam, D604, is still in production at 10 years of age at Rhodes with a calving interval of 368, an MPPA of 106, and a weaning ratio of 108 on seven calves! N501 is moderate, deep and wide, and packed with muscle and lots of character! You won't miss him walking through the bull pen! I have a video of him at 2 weeks of age, and you could already tell he had the herd bull look! Keep the females out of this guy!



N509 is out of a first-calf heifer, he traces back to NSFR TJ B115 – the cornerstone cow that started our registered herd. B115 was known for her sound feet, quality udder, and longevity, producing until 10 years of age. This is the kind of bull to build around: retain the females for the long haul and still raise a uniform, growthy set of feeder calves that will sort themselves at town in the fall.
